



**Warrant
For the Special Town Meeting
August 9, 2004**

TO THE CONSTABLE OF THE TOWN OF NAHANT:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby required forthwith to warn the inhabitants of the Town of Nahant, qualified as the law directs, to assemble at the Town Hall for a Special Town Meeting on Monday the 9th day of August 2004 at 7:30 p.m. then and there to act on Article One.

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to acquire and accept a deed to transfer to the Town approximately 150,000 square feet of land currently owned by the United States Government and commonly known as the Coast Guard housing area on Castle Road, Gardner Road and Goddard Drive under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, section 14; to authorize the Board of Selectmen to exercise the care, custody, management and control of such land for general municipal purposes, until a future Town Meeting shall determine otherwise; to appropriate the sum of \$2,100,000, or any other sum, for such acquisition and related legal and technical services, and to meet this appropriation to authorize the Treasurer, with the permission of the Board of Selectmen, to borrow \$2,100,000 under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 7, clause 3, or any other applicable statute, for a period of up to 20 years, or to borrow the same amount for a shorter period; and to authorize an appropriation for the payment of the first year's interest on such borrowing from the Town's stabilization fund or otherwise; or to take any other action relative thereto.

WHEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return of the Warrant with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting as foresaid.
